# The Lord's Supper Family Faith Talk

### What to do:

Point to each picture below and ask your child:

What do these remind you of? Let every family member respond.







### Read Aloud:

Each picture reminds us of something special. That is what we are doing when we take the Lord's Supper. It reminds us of the last night Jesus spent with his disciples. Read Luke 22:14-20.

### Ask your family:

- What did Jesus say the bread represented in verse 19? (His body given for us.)
- What did Jesus say the wine or juice represented that was in the cup in verse 20? (His blood.)
- Why did Jesus tell us to do this in verse 19? (In remembrance of Me.)
- Why do we take the Lord's Supper? (To remember what Jesus did for us. When He died on the cross, He gave us His body and blood as payment for our sin.
- Just like the cake with candles reminds us of birthday's, the fireworks reminds us of the 4th of July, and the tree with decorations reminds us of Christmas.
- <u>Christians</u> (People who have <u>Admitted</u> they sin, <u>Believe</u> Jesus is God's Son, and <u>Confess</u> their faith in Jesus Christ as their Savior and Lord and have shared their decision to do this with other people) are people who take the Lord's Supper as a reminder to them of Jesus' last meal with the disciples and that Jesus sacrificed himself by dying on the cross, with his body being broken and his blood being shed.
- Also read 1 Corinthians 11:23-30

# Share with your family:

• This Sunday in the Worship Center Christians will be taking part in the Lord's Supper. Which is a symbol to help us remember what Jesus has done for us.

## Pray:

Pray thanking Jesus for dying on the cross for our sins and for modeling the Lord's Supper. Ask him to forgive you of your sins and to help you become a stronger follower of Christ.
